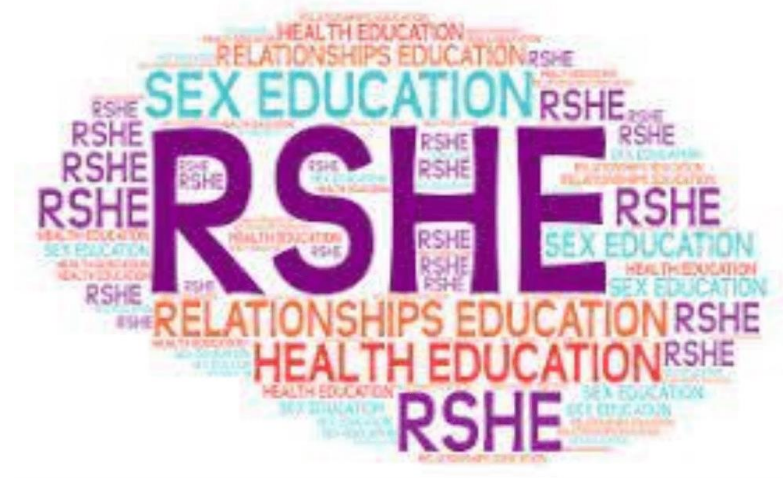

Year 1 - keeping active and safe in the sun

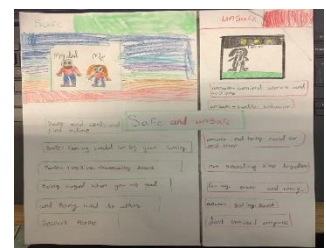
Year 2 - keeping active and looking after our mental wellbeing
